





About the fund:

- Open Mind Fund is a charitable fund organization that helps the people of Ukraine who have suffered from the military action of the Russian Federation.
- The fund was established by the founders of the Atoll Holding group of companies, which is the official manufacturer and distributor of ŠKODA vehicles and spare parts in Ukraine.
- Accordingly, the fund's activities are being performed at the Eurocar plant, one of the holding's facilities. The Holding facilitates the fund with logistical resources required for the prompt reception, sorting and delivery of humanitarian aid directly to the victims in the most affected regions.





Our capabilities:

Thanks to the Eurocar plant, the fund's logistics has wellestablished routes enabling the coordinated delivery of humanitarian aid throughout Ukraine.

We can deliver cargo from Europe by road and rail re-directing it to the most affected regions. Currently, the fund has been collecting humanitarian aid from regional authorities, government agencies, charitable partner organizations and individual patrons.

The logistics hub is located on the plant's premises which has two storage facilities with an area of 7749 square meters and 1892 square meters respectively.

The facilities are located on the border with Slovakia and Hungary. This allows for the prompt reception and efficient distribution of cargo throughout Ukraine.

Eurocar has its own railway terminal with the general length of 1,470 m including the lines of European and Ukrainian types.



Our mission:



1st - goal:

To provide humanitarian aid on the regular basis to the citizens of Ukraine, who cannot leave the cities or towns due to destruction



2nd – goal:

To provide refugees with temporary shelter on the premises on our production plant



3rd – goal:

To develop the software that will allow for transparent accounting of humanitarian aid








How is the supply model different from other Charitable organizations?

Goal 2: Provision of Temporary shelter



More than two and a half million of Ukrainians have left their homes during the course of the war. The number of people searching for shelter is growing exponentially.



We have organized a shelter on the plant's premises for our employees and their families and we aim to extend this opportunity for other refugees across Ukraine.



Currently, we have provided shelter to 160 of Atoll Holding employees and their families



We are working closely with the UNHCR in order to build additional 1000 living spaces for people who are in need of a shelter.





Goal 3: Development of Software for transparent

accounting of humanitarian aid

 The Third Goal is to develop software with the assistance of the Transcarpathian Regional Administration and government agencies.

 There is currently no unified system for organizing humanitarian aid and understanding the needs of the affected residents.

 the development of corresponding software will allow for transparent accounting of humanitarian aid (arrival, accounting, sorting and distribution in Ukraine).

The software will increase the efficiency of the fund, government agencies and humanitarian organizations, which in turn simplifies and speeds up the process of humanitarian aid provision as well as improves transparency and ensures that assistance reaches the most affected people.


